As part of the entrance exam you're given the opportunity to present to us your musical talent and musical prowess in interacting with different genres. These auditions allow us to get to know you as a person as comprehensively as possible, which in turn goes on to inform our ever-present interest in recognising your individual stylistic strengths. You're therefore given the necessary guidance and training, which ultimately enables you to pursue a professional career as a musician and/or music educator.

We invite you to present us with different pieces and styles of music that show us what inspires and drives you and your enthusiasm for music. Diversity is something that we wholeheartedly embrace and we're always open to inspiration through music of different cultures and genres.

In a personal conversation we would like to find out more about your motivation to pursue a professional career in the field of music. Tell us about your previous musical engagements and other relevant activities and what future goals you may have. Of course, you are welcome to send us a letter of motivation and a CV as part of your registration.

Following your musical and personal presentation, a written assessment on music theory rudiments is then given. This test serves as a guide, so as to correctly classify your ability regarding central theoretical subjects such as ear training and general music theory, in which no prior knowledge necessary.

## Steps of the Admission Procedure

### Step 1

Any files regarding your personal details should be in pdf format and sent to us via email to [application@jammusiclab.com](mailto:application@jammusiclab.com) in pdf format. These include the following:

- Copy of a passport or identity card: absolutely compulsory
- Significant material outlining your previous musical experience: optional
- Copies of certificates from previous schools and/or studies: optional
- Curriculum vitae and letter of motivation: optional

### Step 2 - Registration fee

A fee of €50 is required for the entrance exam and is to be transferred to the following account:

After the fee has been successfully transferred, you will receive an appointment for the entrance examination.

### Step 3 - The Entrance Exam

The entrance examination comprises of 3 parts:

1. Musical performance presentation: A programme of 8-10 minutes playing time, consisting of at least 3 different styles (individual movements or excerpts from works are also possible)
2. Personal interview
3. Music theory assessment test
